



TERMS OF REFERENCE

For services to enhance the ratification of the Minamata Convention on Mercury and enable a coordinated implementation of chemicals and waste management Conventions in Latin America and the Caribbean Project ID 150415

1. General Background Information

In January 2013, the intergovernmental negotiating committee concluded its fifth session by agreeing on the text of the Minamata Convention on Mercury. The text was adopted by the Conference of Plenipotentiaries on 10 October 2013 in Japan. The 50-ratification milestone required for the Minamata Convention on Mercury to enter into force was reached on 18 May 2017. As a result, on 16 August 2017, the Minamata Convention will become legally binding for all its Parties as required by the Convention provisions. The objective of the Convention is to protect human health and the environment from anthropogenic emissions and releases of mercury and mercury compounds and it sets out a range of measures to meet that objective. In the context of the project promoting ratification and early implementation of the Minamata Convention on mercury funded by the Government of Switzerland, United Nations Industrial Development Organization UNIDO is going to arrange a regional event during the preparatory meeting for COP 1 Minamata for countries from Latin America and the Caribbean in Buenos Aires.

2. Aim of the Project

Overall objective of the project is facilitating a regional approach in the early implementation of the Convention but also to explore how to address the hazardous waste management with a broader approach and build on existing structures.

This project complements and is coordinated with the regional preparatory meeting for the first Conference of the Parties (COP 1) arranged by the interim Minamata Convention Secretariat and the Basel Convention regional coordination center in Buenos Aires.

3. The Scope of the proposed Contracted Services

The following activities are to be undertaken in order to arrange the regional event promoting an early implementation of the Minamata Convention and where beneficial to conduct this in a synergetic manner with other Multilateral Environmental Agreements in the Chemicals and Waste sector:

- Organize, secure and pay for adequate logistic, administrative and technical arrangements for a 2 hours side event at the regional preparatory meeting for the COP 1 Minamata in Buenos Aires for up to 60 people.
- Make the necessary arrangements for accommodation, organize lunch for all participants to the regional side event
- Assist one expert of each of the 4 regional coordination centers for the Basel, Stockholm and Minamata Convention in GRULAC located in Panama, Trinidad Tobago, Uruguay and Brazil as may be needed in arranging accommodation to attend the side event and the regional preparatory meeting for the COP 1 Minamata in Buenos Aires.

- Distribute a reduced Daily Subsistence Allowance to the four experts from the regional coordination center for the Basel, Stockholm and Minamata Convention.
- Arrange for English-Spanish simultaneous interpretation available for standard UN working hours including sound equipment, microphones, interpreting booth and technical support during the side event.

4. Language Requirements

All reports and summaries should be prepared in English.

5. General Time Schedule

The activities in this contract shall be finalized no later than 3 months after the contract is awarded.
