An initial questionnaire has been prepared in order to carry out a survey of the national and international regulatory context of the countries and their technical capacities. This questionnaire was disseminated at the project launch workshop and is being completed by the participating countries. Currently, bilateral meetings are being held with the competent authorities of the countries in the region to evaluate the waste management capacity of lead acid batteries and electronic waste in the Latin American region.
